Thank you for your interest in the Portland Police Department. This letter is to serve as a confirmation of the upcoming entry level police officer testing. Dates and times for the written exam are as follows: Saturday, May 22 at 9 AM and 11 AM , Tuesday May 25 at 8:30 AM, 10:30 AM and 4:00 PM; and Wednesday May 26<sup>th</sup> at 8:30 AM, 10:30 AM and 4:00 PM and Wednesday June 2<sup>nd</sup> at 2 PM and 5:30 PM. The fitness tests are being held on Saturday, May 22 at 2 PM and Tuesday, May 25th at 9 AM and 1 PM and Wednesday June 2nd at 4 PM. Please call Police Personnel at (207) 874-8588 to schedule your testing dates. When you schedule your testing session please indicate which fitness test date and time you would prefer. As a reminder, if you have completed the fitness test within the past year with either the Portland Police Department or the Maine Criminal Justice Academy there is no need to retest; please provide a copy of the test if possible on the day of your written exam. If you haven't already applied please go to [www.portland-police.com](http://www.portland-police.com) where you can find more information regarding the hiring process and application materials

Should you pass both portions of the testing, we are holding interviews shortly after the testing dates. We ask that you bring the completed Employment Background Booklet on the day of the interview. The background booklet is fairly extensive and can be time consuming, and gathering the materials requested can be even more so. We realize this and want you to be as prepared as possible and have ample time to devote to completing it. Therefore, I would advise you to go to our website (<http://police.portlandmaine.gov/careers.asp>) and look at the Background Booklet as soon as possible to get a sense of the questions asked, materials needed, and the time necessary to complete it as thoroughly as possible before the upcoming interview process. Background Booklets are not required until after the testing process, so please refrain from bringing them on the day of the exam.
